


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DOUBLE DOUBLE TROUBLE by LeXman



You have been presented with three exactly identical grids.

For each matching trio (all three 1 Acrosses, for example), you will find two of the grid entries by solving the clues listed in pairs under the appropriate number in the "Across" and "Down" lists. These clues are presented in random order; it is up to the solver to determine which of the three grids each of the two answers goes in.


The third answer for each set must be derived from the clues, also in random order, listed under "Either."

Because the three grids are identical, it doesn't matter in which order you fill them out, but there is only one configuration of all fifty-four answers that will properly fill all three grids.
