Several unchecked squares in this grid must pull double duty, either because:

- (a) both the Across and Down entries are too long by one letter, but share a bigram where the two words cross (which you should enter into the grid as "A and B"), or
- (b) the Across and Down entries both have the appropriate number of letters, but they provide two different letters where the words cross (which you should enter into the grid as "A or B").

A pattern will quickly emerge, which will provide a seasonally appropriate phrase. This phrase must be provided along with the completed grid.
