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
DOUBLE TROUBLE by LeXman

Each clue number (except 16 Across) appears in the grid twice and has been assigned two different clues. It is up to the solver to determine which of the two clues provides the entry for each half of the grid.

In the case of five of these pairs of clues, however, one of the clues provides two different valid solutions: one for each half of the grid. The remaining clue in each of these cases will provide the solver with a three-letter word which, when all five are taken together, provide the cryptic clue to 16 Across.




